Dear Calvary Family,

## *Pastor's Paragraph*

"That I may know Him and the power of His resurrection" is from Philippians 3:10, where the apostle Paul expresses his desire for a profound, personal relationship with Jesus Christ, beyond mere intellectual understanding. This verse is not just a theological statement; it is a cry of the heart, a declaration of life's highest pursuit. In a few short words, Paul captures the essence of Christian discipleship: a yearning to know Christ intimately and to experience the life-altering power that raised Him from the dead.



To understand the depth of Paul's longing, one must first consider the context. In Philippians 3, Paul lists all the things he could once boast about: his heritage, his religious zeal, his moral record. But in verse 7, he declares, "But whatever gain I had, I counted as loss for the sake of Christ." Paul dismantles every human credential and places all his confidence in Christ alone. He is not satisfied with religious achievement or theological precision; he wants Christ Himself. The phrase "that I may know Him" speaks to a deeply relational, experiential knowledge, not merely information about Jesus, but life in communion with Him.

In Scripture, the word "know" often implies intimacy, even covenantal closeness. It is the kind of knowing that transforms a person from the inside out. Paul's hunger is not for doctrinal theory, but for divine encounter. He has already met Christ on the Damascus Road, and yet his longing persists. This tells us something vital: to know Christ is a never-ending pursuit. The closer one walks with Him, the more one desires Him. Christian maturity is not measured by how much we know about God but by how deeply we know Him personally.

But Paul does not stop at "knowing Him." He continues with, "and the power of His resurrection." This is not a disjointed idea. It is a natural extension of knowing Christ. To truly know Jesus is to encounter His resurrection power. This power is not merely a historical event confined to the empty tomb. It is a present reality for every believer. Paul is speaking of a spiritual force that raises the dead and brings them to life, a power that breaks the chains of sin, reorders priorities, and infuses divine strength into human weakness. The resurrection of Jesus was the ultimate demonstration of God's power over sin, death, and the grave.

What does it mean, practically, to know the power of His resurrection? It means that in our deepest despair, hope rises. In our weakest moments, strength is given. In our habitual sins, there is deliverance. The resurrection power of Christ is not theoretical; it is transformational. It changes desires, heals brokenness, restores relationships, and empowers obedience. It is the power that fuels sanctification and makes holiness possible.

As believers, our greatest aim should mirror Paul's: not merely to believe in Jesus, but to know Him; not only to celebrate His resurrection, but to live in its power daily; not simply to avoid suffering, but to embrace it as a pathway to deeper fellowship with Christ. As we walk this path of knowing Him and the power of His resurrection, we will find what Paul found: that everything else is loss compared to the surpassing worth of knowing Christ Jesus our Lord.
